

Right of Way Permit Policy
Dumpsters Placed in the Right of Way
January 28, 1999

It is the policy of the City of Monroe that all dumpsters that are being used for any private development work be located within the public street right of way.

In cases where there is not room on the private development site or there is not adequate room for the truck delivering the dumpster to place the dumpster on the site, the following shall be required to place the dumpster within the street right of way:

1. A right of way permit must be obtained from the City of Monroe Engineering Department.
2. The owner of the dumpster shall be required to secure the right of way permit. The property owner and the development contractor shall not be permitted to secure the right of way permit.
3. **The applicant must submit a right of way permit application and a sketch of the proposed dumpster location to the Engineering Department. The sketch must provide dimensions of the dumpster size and distances to cross walks.**
4. **Dumpsters placed within the street right of way must be reviewed and approved by the Engineering and Police Departments before a right of way permit will be issued.**
5. A License Permit Bond in the amount of \$1500 must be provided by the dumpster owner.
6. A certificate of insurance meeting the requirements of City Ordinance 84-002 must be provided by the dumpster owner.
7. The placement of the dumpster on the street pavement shall be no closer to an intersection than 25' from the cross walk. In no case shall the dumpster be an obstruction to vision of vehicular traffic.
8. The two corners of the dumpster placed **on the pavement** closest to the traffic travel lane shall be protected by lighted MDOT Type I traffic drums.
9. Dumpsters placed on asphalt surfaces shall be set upon wood blocking.
10. Dumpsters may be placed in the green belt terrace area as long as the public sidewalk is not blocked and sufficient space is available. Curbs must be blocked and ramped if the truck must cross the curb to place the dumpster. Dumpsters shall not be placed on the curbing or the sidewalk.

11. Dumpsters shall only be placed on the street in the parking lane. Dumpsters shall not be permitted on streets locations where parking is prohibited. When the dumpster is placed in a parking lane, the dumpster owner shall secure appropriate no parking signs from the City of Monroe Police Department.
12. No dumpster shall be placed on a street pavement location for a time period exceeding five working days. The dumpsters shall be placed no earlier than 6 AM Monday and shall be removed by 6 PM Friday. Dumpsters shall not be permitted on any street location on the Weekend days.
13. All dumpsters placed in the street right of way must bear the owners name and telephone number.
14. **Any dumpster that is placed within the street right of way under an issued right of way permit shall be ordered to be removed and not replaced if the location of the dumpster becomes a traffic and/or safety hazard.**
