- When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3500 square feet in area.
- Work completed by government subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00

**V. HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT AND SIGNATURE**

Section 23a of the state construction code act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirement of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. Violators of section 23a are subject to civil fines.

I hereby certify the electrical work described on this permit application shall be installed by myself, in my own home in which I am living or about to occupy. VI. FEE CLARIFICATIONS

**Items #1 and #26 Rough Inspections**

The application fee includes one inspection, if the project requires more than one inspection, as in a trench inspection and a rough, or a rough and a final, the applicant needs to include these fees or you will be billed for them later. Consequently there will be no more inspections done until these fees are paid.

**Items #27 & #28 Re-Inspections and reactivate**

A re-inspection fee will be charged if the installation does not meet minimum code requirements on the first inspection. A reactivation fee will be charged for permits that have expired.

IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

General: Electrical work shall not be started until the permit has been issued by the City of Monroe, Building Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been approved.** When ready for an inspection, call the City of Monroe Building Department (734-384-9786). Please provide 24 hr notice. The inspector will need the **job location and permit number**. EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED.**
