## V. APPLICANTS SIGNATURE

## VII.a. FEE CLARIFICATIONS

WHEN setting a mobil home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

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IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

<p>GENERAL PLUMBING work shall not be started until the permit has been issued by the City of Monroe Building Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the State of Michigan Mechanical Code. <b>No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.</b> When ready for an inspection, call the City of Monroe Building Department (734-384-9186). Please provide 24 hr notice. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.</p>
<p>EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.</p>
